




Q1: Do you think that police should be allowed to pursue suspected criminals?






Q3: Would you support my proposal to move people off the streets into secure shelter areas with counseling that prohibits drug and alcohol use with existing tax dollars?






Q5: Do you support the payroll tax to fund a state-run long-term care program to cover approximately 90 days of care that you cannot take out of state?




Q6: Should the state continue to impose a carbon tax that has resulted in an increase in gas prices by more than 50 cents per gallon?
